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## Aim and team

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- To support an inclusive dissemination strategy to promote the health app quality label

## Setup of the subproject

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- Developing **communication prototypes** by means of **co-creation with the target group** (i.e., patients, citizens, carers).
- Test whether the communication prototypes support understanding and informed decision making among the target group, and particularly among users with lower levels of health literacy.



## Aims

- (1) To identify aspects that prevent understanding and informed use of the label that should be addressed in the supporting communication.
- (2) Collect input and insights for the supporting communication in terms of content, timing, and channels.

## Three **interactive co-creation** tasks:

- (1) Customer journey
- (2) Mapping understanding of the elements of label and ranking importance
- (3) Choosing an app based on the label

Where should the information be provided to you?

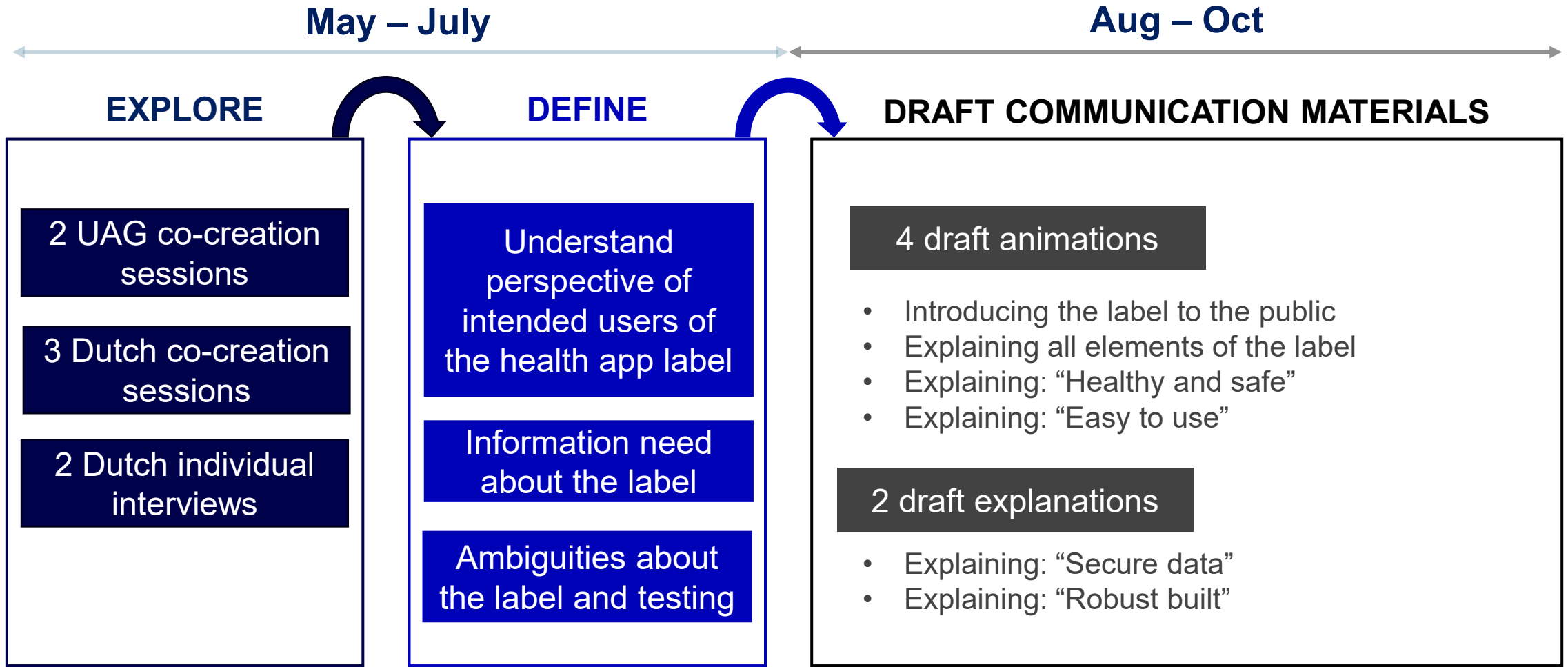


At which point(s) of the journey would a label help you out? How?
